The palms we brought home last weekend were blessed. As they are now a holy object, we will want to treat them with reverence, including proper disposal. We may keep our palms as long as we wish. When we do decide to part with them, we may use one of the following methods: Burn the palms; bury them in the ground where they will decompose; or, cut them into small pieces (one to two inches). The ashes or small pieces are no longer considered blessed. Note: The ashes used for the blessing on Ash Wednesday are from burned palms.
