Without this grace it becomes difficult to grow in holiness. We are inclined not to give God his rightful first place in our lives. Have we come to believe this sacrament is unnecessary because we have accepted everything as 'okay'? Are we convinced that, except for the big things like murder, there is really no sin? The fact is, the definition of sin and the many forms of sin have not changed. We need to ask for God's forgiveness. Be free from the bondage of such things as un-forgiveness and resentment toward others, bad habits, addictions, etc. Experience God's great love, His mercy, forgiveness and His healing power through the Sacrament of Reconciliation!
